


How to relink Kaltura media in Moodle

There are two methods to re-link media depending on how the original media was posted:

- If the original media was posted using the **Kaltura Video Resource tool**, you can use the Replace media button in Edit settings.
- If the media was embedded in a text field (label, page, forum post, book, description) using the **Kaltura button** in the text editor, you will have to delete the embed code and re-apply it.

How to re-link media in a Kaltura Video Resource:

1. Log into Moodle and navigate to your course
2. Turn editing on
3. Locate the Kaltura Video Resource you want to re-link, click Edit and choose Edit Settings from the dropdown menu:




4. In the Edit Settings menu, scroll down to the video section and click the Replace media button:

5. A new window with your My Media content should appear. Locate your media file, either by scrolling down or using the search field, and click Embed:




6. Be sure to click Save at the bottom of the page before navigating away from the page.


How to replace embedded media:

The instructions below show how to edit a label with a Kaltura video embedded in it.

1. Log into Moodle and navigate to your course
2. Turn editing on
3. Locate the embedded Kaltura media that needs to be re-linked, click Edit and choose Edit Settings from the dropdown menu:




4. In the Edit menu, delete the existing embed code and click the Kaltura button to find the media in your My Media list to re-apply:

5. Your My Media folder will show in a new window. Locate your media by scrolling or using the search field, and click 'Embed' to generate new embed code:
