**FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS**

**What are the scholarship application requirements?**

- Please fill out the entire application form in full; incomplete applications will not be considered.
- Eligibility for this scholarship is only open to students of Aboriginal ancestry and who are 15-18 years old at the time of registration.
- The application needs to be signed by the student as well as a parent or guardian.

**What is the selection process?**

Aboriginal Scholarships are available on a first-come, first-serve basis providing there is still space in the program.

**What type of a student are we looking for?**

We are looking for students who will be committed to coming to Emily Carr and the Vancouver Art Gallery for each session for the full duration the program.

We are looking for students who are passionate about art and design, and who may like to pursue a future career in the creative industries.

Some of the attributes we are looking for in a student include:

- Curiosity and open-mindedness
- Capacity for hard work, experimentation and exploration
- Engagement with a range of media and a love of material exploration

**What is the selection process?**

Following the application deadline, a selection committee will review applications. Successful applicants will be notified by September 17, 2021.

**What is the schedule?**

Students meet twice a month from October 7, 2021 to May 12, 2022, from 4:00 pm to 7:00 pm. Classes are scheduled on the first and third Thursday, each month. Sessions alternate between the Vancouver Art Gallery and Emily Carr University.

**Where is the program located?**

The program is a joint program and takes place at the Vancouver Art Gallery and at Emily Carr University of Art + Design.

**Please note:** Program activities for 2021-2022 are expected to take place in person, but we are prepared to pivot our programming online should the circumstances require us to do so.
