

HEALTH DESIGN AWARD FOR SERVICE

APPLICATION

ELIGIBILITY:

Graduate and undergraduate students working in the area of Health Design are invited to apply for the Health Design Award for Service. A jury will select a student to receive a \$500 graduation award based on students' submissions demonstrating how they have provided service and advanced the field of health design.

Note: students must have worked with an external user, health organization or company in order to qualify for the award, in a volunteer or paid design position.

AWARD CRITERIA:

The winning applicant will be selected based on:

- Student's work in the area of health design while at Emily Carr University (not limited to their graduating year)
- How the project(s) have provided service and advanced the role of health design
- The impact of their involvement and service
- Overall quality of work and communication

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS:

- Submission will include a digital PDF of up to 1,000 words and up to five (5) images in support of their application, including:
 - Project name(s)
 - initiatives and/or organizations with which they've been involved (these may be over the course of their time at Emily Carr University),
 - Student's role and contribution to the projects, including other contributors, group members, and health organizations/companies involved
 - Timeframe of project(s) and how the project(s) have advanced the field of health design
 - Methods and approaches used
 - Images must be clearly captioned
