

# HOW MUCH WILL IT COST TO STUDY AT EMILY CARR UNIVERSITY?

This budget estimation tool helps predict costs to study as a domestic and international graduate student at Emily Carr University for the 2020/2021 academic year (Fall + Spring semester only).

The following budget estimate is based on average costs. Vancouver is an expensive city to live in and costs can vary widely depending on if you are living on your own or in shared accommodations. The following estimates are very conservative so when you do your own budget, be sure to budget for your own circumstance.
