WHAT TO EXPECT FOR ONLINE LEARNING

Welcome to the Emily Carr University of Art + Design Junior Art Intensive!

ZOOM	Your JAI online studio course will be hosted in Zoom. If you have not used Zoom before, please download it here , and make sure that you grant access to your camera and microphone. Test your Zoom settings in advance to ensure you can join your classes smoothly!
MOODLE	Moodle is our learning management system for access to course materials, assignments, and resources. Your login username can be found in your Welcome letter, and a secondary email from CSMoodle@ecuad.ca will be sent to you with your password. Please log into Moodle and activate your account following these instructions before the start of the program.
FIRST DAY	The Online Welcome Assembly is scheduled to take place on Zoom, one week prior the program start date. During the assembly, students will be introduced to staff and instructors, who will provide a general overview of important information and community expectations. Students who need assistance logging into Moodle, or who are having tech-related troubles are asked to stay behind for troubleshooting before they go.

OUTDOOR ACTIVITIES

Some instructors may encourage students to take a short walk or visit their neighborhood park during class hours to practice observational drawing. These activities would not be mandatory, and students should only participate in them if they feel safe and comfortable doing so. Instructors will discuss these optional activities in class with students.

ONLINE EXHIBITION

The Summer Teens Exhibition website is an online exhibition of student work. The online exhibition will be launched once all student works have been submitted in mid to late August.



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CERTIFICATES OF COMPLETION

Teens who successfully complete the program will receive a Certificate of Completion via email. To receive the certificate, students must successfully complete the program by demonstrating consistent engagement and completion of assignments.
