This means that the applicant is the University and faculty leading the research will be the Project Leader (unless otherwise allowed by the funding agency). These grants involve industry partnerships. Faculty interested in learning more about these grants and applying are advised to contact the Research + Industry Office.

College and Community Innovation Program - Applied Research and Development Grants (CCI - ARD): ARD

Applied Research and Development grants support research and development (R&D) projects led by college researchers in partnership with private sector, public sector or not-for-profit organizations based in Canada while encouraging collaboration with universities and/or other colleges. Direct project costs are shared by the partner organization(s) and funding agency.

- Award amounts: up to \$150,000

College and Community Innovation Program – College and Community Social Innovation Fund (CCSIF)

CCSIF grants are intended to foster community innovation by connecting the talent, facilities and capabilities of Canada's colleges and polytechnics with the research needs of community organizations. CCSIF proposals should facilitate collaborative and innovative research that brings together researchers, students and partners to address challenges in community innovation in the social sciences, humanities, health sciences, natural sciences and engineering research fields.

- Deadlines: March 1
- Award amounts: up to \$120,000 per year
